The British School of Judo Excellence have performed a demonstration of judo at school and will be running a course of judo for 5 consecutive weeks in school as an extracurricular activity.

Judo is a modern Olympic sport enjoyed equally by girls and boys and involves close quarter grappling. Unlike most other martial arts, *judo does not involve kicking, punching or striking*...it translates from Japanese to English as 'The gentle way'. Judo not only aids physical development but is a great stimulant mentally and provides participating children with an overall sense of well being.

All coaches are black belts affiliated to the British Judo Association and are CRB/DBS approved.

Places are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis or at the discretion of the head teacher. Please return your remittance with the reply slip. You will be notified by school if your child has successfully secured a place. Once accepted onto the course, payment regrettably is non refundable.
